- Labconco owns 160,000 square feet of manufacturing space and 22,000 square feet of office space in Kansas City, Missouri.
- Labconco owns 80,000 square feet of manufacturing space and 5,000 square feet of office space in Fort Scott, Kansas.
- Many of Labconco's most popular products are available to ship within 48 hours after receipt of order. Most of our other products are available to ship within 4 to 6 weeks of order.
- More than 95% of Labconco's raw material and component suppliers are US based.
- Stainless and cold rolled steel used in our manufacturing is sourced from US steel mills.
- Labconco is ISO 9001 certified, one measure of our commitment to quality and consistency in design and manufacturing.
